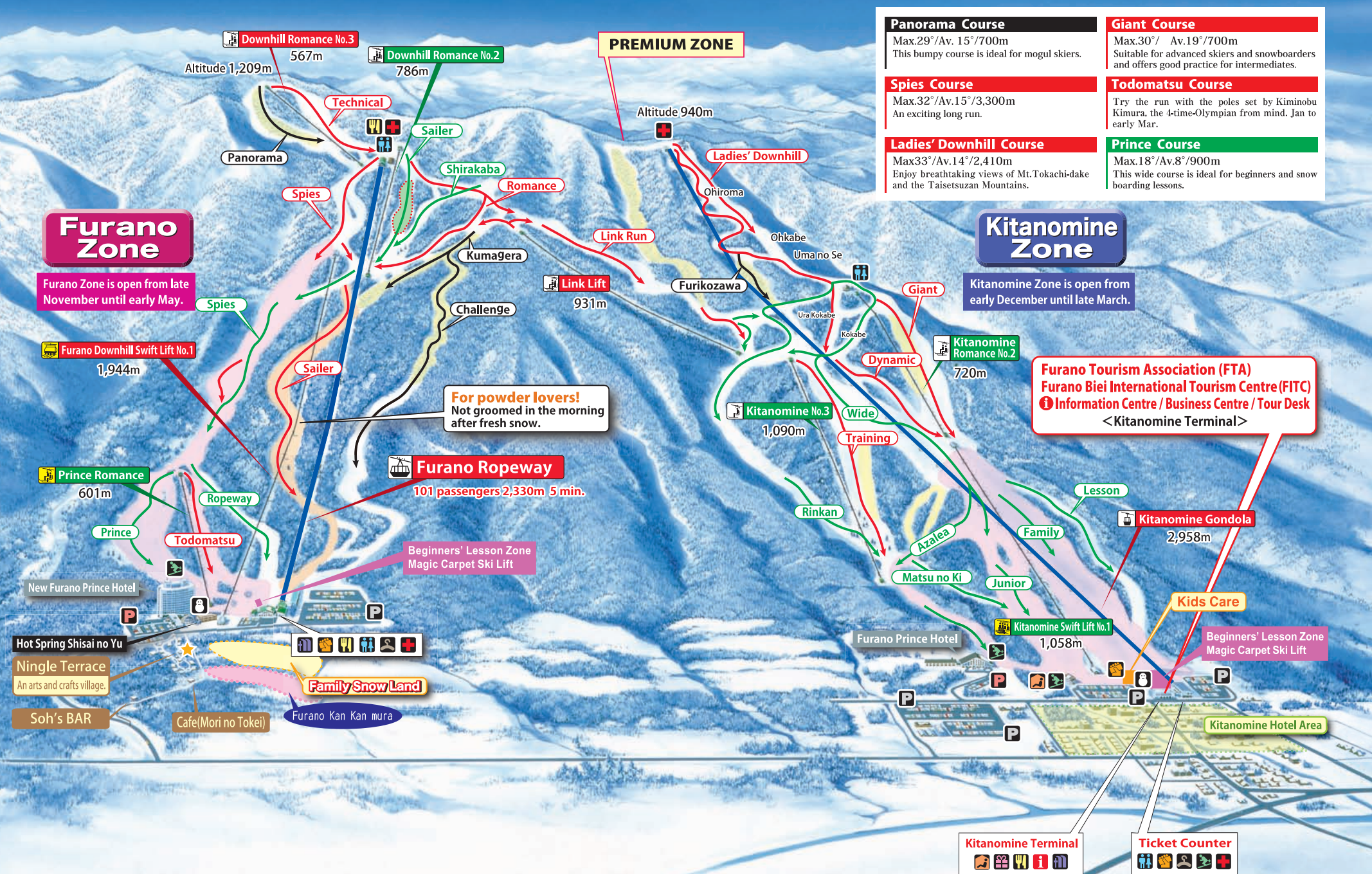


Hokkaido Japan Furano Ski Area
